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PUBLIC NOTICE

On May 29, 2015 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) received from PacifiCorp a Notice of Intent to file an application for a new license and a Pre-Application Document (PAD) for its Weber Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 1744). PacifiCorp hereby requests to use the Alternative Licensing Process (ALP) for this new license application. The current FERC license will expire on May 31, 2020.

The Weber Hydroelectric Project is located near the mouth of Weber Canyon, on the Weber River, approximately 30 miles northeast of Salt Lake City and nine miles southeast of Ogden, Utah. The applicant's address is as follows:

Pursuant to FERC regulations at 18 CFR 4.34(i) regarding the ALP, an applicant is required to prepare and submit a request to FERC for permission to use the ALP and must show that it has made an effective and sufficient outreach to interested entities. An interest group was formed in March 2015 and meetings were held in March and April of 2015. The interest group has reviewed the draft PAD and their comments have been incorporated into the final PAD. All materials related to Weber relicensing will be available for download at the website noted above, or for public viewing and copying during business hours at the Salt Lake PacifiCorp address noted above, or mailed to you upon request. Please contact PacifiCorp if you are interested in further participation in the Weber relicensing process. Comments on the request to use the ALP, if any, must be filed with FERC within 30 days of this public notice (original notice filed 29 May 2015), or by 10 August 2015. Comments must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission in accordance with filing procedures posted on the FERC web site at <http://www.ferc.gov> and must reference FERC No. 1744.
