Dear Mr. Jakubiak:

By letter dated March 22, 2006, you submitted on behalf of PacifiCorp, revised tariff sheets in compliance with a September 16, 2005 unpublished letter order.¹ Waiver of the Commission's notice requirement pursuant to section 35.11 of the regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted, and the revised tariff sheets are accepted for filing effective April 1, 2006, as requested.

Notice of the filing was issued on March 31, 2006, with comments due on or before April 12, 2006. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting

such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Tariffs and Market Development – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
