Dear Ms. Salas:

PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 77.

PacifiCorp and the Montana Power Company ("Montana") are parties to an agreement dated May 24, 1967 providing each party with 50 megawatts of non-firm transmission service on the transmission system of the other party. This agreement was filed with the Commission on June 14, 1967 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 77. Rate Schedule No. 77 is to terminate under its own terms and conditions upon ninety days' notification by either party to the other. This notification was sent by PacifiCorp to NorthWestern Energy (on behalf of Montana) by letter dated November 8, 2004 notifying Montana of the termination to be effective on March 8, 2005. Therefore the June 14, 1967 agreement will have no further effect as of March 8, 2005.

For the reasons stated above the agreement is no longer effective and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 77.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that an effective date of March 8, 2005 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.
