Dear Ms. Salas:

PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette;
2. The November 9, 2004 letter agreement between PacifiCorp and Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Coos-Curry") terminating an August 19, 1950 emergency interconnection agreement; and
3. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 51.

PacifiCorp and Coos-Curry are parties to an agreement dated August 19, 1950 providing for an emergency interconnection between the parties' 69 kV transmission systems in southwestern Oregon and northwestern California. This agreement was filed with the Commission on July 31, 1964 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 51. By letter agreement dated November 9, 2004, PacifiCorp and Coos-Curry agreed to the termination of Rate Schedule No. 51 effective on December 31, 2004. There is currently no replacement agreement since Coos-Curry's transmission system is now operated at 115 kV and the interconnection of these systems would not be possible without the addition of transmission facilities.

For the reasons stated above the agreement is no longer effective and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 51.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.

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Take notice that on _____, PacifiCorp tendered for filing in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations a Notice of Cancellation of the August 19, 1950 agreement between PacifiCorp and the Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. providing for an emergency interconnection between the parties' transmission systems (PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 51).


Enclosed for your information is a copy of the August 19, 1950 Agreement between PacifiCorp (then the California-Oregon Power Company) and Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. That agreement provided for a normally closed interconnection between PacifiCorp's northern California 69 kV transmission system and Coos-Curry's 69 kV transmission system near Brookings, Oregon. In addition, the agreement provided for standby electric service.

It is PacifiCorp's belief that this agreement is no longer necessary. The interconnection no longer exists. It appears that Coos-Curry's 69 kV system is now a 115 kV system while PacifiCorp's system is still operated at 69 kV. According to section 12(b) of the agreement, it may be terminated upon one year's notice, however, since the systems are no longer the same voltage, any closing of that interconnection would not be possible. Therefore, PacifiCorp proposes that the agreement be terminated as of December 31, 2004. If Coos-Curry concurs with this proposal, please sign this letter and return a fully executed copy to me. Otherwise, PacifiCorp hereby notifies Coos-Curry that the agreement will terminate on November 9, 2005.
