PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

By letter dated December 29, 1993 under FERC Docket No. ER94-786-000 PacifiCorp filed a Certificate of Concurrence in a filing of a non-firm transmission service agreement by Idaho Power Company ("Idaho"). By letter dated June 22, 1994, the Commission accepted Idaho's rate filing and designated it as Idaho's Rate Schedule FERC No. 117 effective on December 10, 1968. PacifiCorp's Certificate of Concurrence was designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 367.


Idaho's Rate Schedule 117 has terminated. By letter dated December 19, 2003 under FERC Docket No. ER04-317-000 Idaho filed a request that its Rate Schedule 117 be terminated. The Commission accepted Idaho's filing in its order dated February 17, 2004 and designated Idaho's Rate Schedule 117 as terminated effective on December 31, 2003. With the termination of Idaho's Rate Schedule 117, PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule 367 no longer has any affect and should be terminated also.

For the reasons stated above PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 367 is no longer effective and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 367.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.


