PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette;
2. The May 24, 2000 notification from Western Area Power Administration ("Western") terminating the August 27, 1956 transmission agreement between PacifiCorp and Western; and
3. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 72.

PacifiCorp and the Western Area Power Administration ("Western") are parties to an agreement dated August 27, 1956 providing for low voltage transmission service to Western's customers at Hanover and Bluff Substations in Wyoming (contract No. 14-06-600-2009). This agreement was filed with the Commission on October 9, 1956 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 72. Rate Schedule No. 72 was terminated by Western's notice to PacifiCorp dated May 24, 2000. This service is now provided to Western under Network Transmission Service arrangements.

For the reasons stated above the agreement is no longer effective or necessary and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 72.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.



Dear Mr. Steinbach:

PacifiCorp and Western Area Power Administration ("Western") are parties to the August 27, 1956 Contract for Transmission of Electric Service at Distribution Voltage, Contract No. 14-06-600-2009. Under such contract, PacifiCorp charges Western for use of its distribution system for the Bluff No. 1 and Hanover No. 4 points-of-delivery which receive power and energy over PacifiCorp's transmission system under Contract No. 14-06-400-2437 ("Contract 2437").

Western has provided notice of termination of Contract 2437 effective May 31, 2000. The transmission service provided Western under Contract 2437 will be provided, effective June 1, 2000, under a Network Integration Transmission Service Agreement under PacifiCorp's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("Network Agreement"). The charge for network transmission service under the Network Agreement includes rates for service on PacifiCorp's distribution system. Therefore, PacifiCorp and Western hereby mutually agree to terminate Contract No. 14-06-600-2009 effective May 31, 2000.
