PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 50.


PacifiCorp and Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. are parties to an agreement dated June 20, 1962 providing an emergency interconnection at the Prineville 69 kV substation and standby electric service between the parties' systems. This agreement was filed with the Commission on July 31, 1964 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 50. Rate Schedule No. 50 terminated under its own terms and conditions on September 10, 1968. In addition, the emergency interconnection was placed under the terms and conditions of the August 9, 1973 Exchange Agreement between PacifiCorp and Bonneville Power Administration (PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 114). By letter dated November 23, 2004, PacifiCorp notified Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. of its intent to terminate Rate Schedule No. 50.

For the reasons stated above the agreement is no longer effective or necessary and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 50.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.


