PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 52.

PacifiCorp and the City of Milton-Freewater, Washington ("Milton-Freewater") are parties to an agreement dated May 26, 1960 providing an emergency interconnection at Freewater 69 kV substation and standby electric service between the parties' systems. This agreement was filed with the Commission on July 31, 1964 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 52. Rate Schedule No. 52 is to terminate under its own terms and conditions on May 26, 1965 but only upon notification by either party to the other. Freewater substation and the 69 kV transmission system in the vicinity are no longer owned by PacifiCorp. The transmission system is now owned by the Bonneville Power Administration and as a result, the interconnection between PacifiCorp and Milton-Freewater no longer physically exists. By letter dated November 23, 2004, PacifiCorp notified Milton-Freewater of its intent to terminate Rate Schedule No. 52.

For the reasons stated above the agreement is no longer effective or necessary and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 52.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.


