PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 317.

PacifiCorp and Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems ("UAMPS") are parties to an agreement dated October 30, 1991 ("Central O&M Agreement") providing for the operation and maintenance of UAMPS' Central Substation by PacifiCorp. This agreement was filed with the Commission on November 27, 1991 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 317. By letter dated May 31, 1995 UAMPS notified PacifiCorp pursuant to section 1.2 of the Central O&M Agreement that this agreement would terminate on August 31, 1995 and that after that date UAMPS would perform all of the operation and maintenance requirements for its Central Substation. Therefore the Central O&M Agreement has had no effect as of August 31, 1995.

For the reasons stated above the Central O&M Agreement is no longer effective and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 317.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.

On or before the comment date, it is not necessary to serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.


