PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 264.

PacifiCorp, the Washington Water Power Company ("WWP"), Idaho Power Company ("IPC"), the Montana Power Company ("MPC") and Utah Power & Light Company ("Utah") are parties to an agreement dated April 21, 1965 providing for the construction, ownership, operation and maintenance of certain 230 kV and 161 kV facilities in states of Idaho and Montana now commonly referred to as the AMPS Line. This agreement was filed with the Commission by Utah on November 8, 1965 and was accepted for filing and designated as Utah's Rate Schedule FERC No. 103. The agreement was also filed with the Commission by PacifiCorp on November 8, 1965 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 70. By letter dated July 13, 1990 under FERC Docket No. ER89-573-000, the Commission re-designated Utah's Rate Schedule FERC No. 103 to PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 264 as a result of the merger between PacifiCorp and Utah Power & Light Company.

The dual rate schedule designation of the April 21, 1965 AMPS Line Agreement is not necessary. The agreement is still in effect and PacifiCorp continues to provide contractually agreed to services to WWP, IPC and MPC. PacifiCorp is hereby requesting termination of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 264. PacifiCorp proposes no changes to Rate Schedule 70. The purpose of this filing is to eliminate the duplicate rate schedule designation for this agreement.

For the reasons stated above Rate Schedule No 264 is no longer necessary and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 264.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.
