Dear Mr. Persichetti and Mr. Stamper:

On October 22, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-61-000 that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 313 between PacifiCorp and Western Area Power Administration. On November 30, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-274-000 that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 51 between PacifiCorp and Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. Also on November 30, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-275-000 that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 367 between PacifiCorp and Idaho Power Company. On December 6, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-297-000 that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 53 between PacifiCorp and Tillamook People's Utility District. Also on December 6, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-300-000 that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 285 between PacifiCorp and U.S. Defense Depot Ogden. On December 15, 2004, PacifiCorp filed a Notice of Cancellation in Docket No. ER05-339-000, that cancels Rate Schedule FERC No. 264. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R § 35.11) is granted, and each of the separate Notice of Cancellation as referenced above is accepted for filing effective

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December 31, 2004, as requested. The rate schedule designations included in the referenced dockets are correct.

Notices of these filings, notices were issued on October 27, 2004, December 6, 2004, December 8, 2004 and on December 21, 2004. Comments, protests, or motions to intervene were due on or before November 12, 2004, December 21, 2004, December 27, 2004, and January 5, 2005, respectively. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
