PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:

1. Notice of Filing with diskette; and
2. Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 255.

PacifiCorp, Pacific Gas & Electric Company ("PG&E"), Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") and Utah Power & Light Company ("Utah") are parties to an agreement dated February 12, 1988 providing for the installation and operation of phase shifting transformers on the system of Utah in order to mitigate loop flow. This agreement was filed with the Commission by Utah on March 8, 1989 and was accepted for filing and designated as Utah's Rate Schedule FERC No. 147. The agreement was also filed with the Commission by PacifiCorp on March 1, 1989 and was accepted for filing and designated as PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 255. By letter dated July 13, 1990 under FERC Docket No. ER89-573-000, the Commission re-designated Utah's Rate Schedule FERC No. 147 to PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 298 as a result of the merger between PacifiCorp and Utah Power & Light Company.

The dual rate schedule designation of the February 12, 1988 Loop Flow Mitigation Agreement is not necessary. The agreement is still in effect and PacifiCorp continues to bill PG&E and SCE for phase shifter charges. PacifiCorp's filings of amendments to this agreement since the merger have all been filed as amendments to Rate Schedule 298. PacifiCorp therefore is hereby requesting termination of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 255. PacifiCorp proposes no changes to Rate Schedule 298. The purpose of this filing is to eliminate the duplicate rate schedule designation for this agreement.

For the reasons stated above Rate Schedule No 255 is no longer necessary and PacifiCorp has prepared and filed herewith its Notice of Cancellation of PacifiCorp's Rate Schedule FERC No. 255.

PacifiCorp requests, pursuant to 18 CFR 35.11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, that a waiver of prior notice be granted and that an effective date of December 31, 2004 be assigned to the Notice of Cancellation.

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
