PacifiCorp files herewith, in accordance with 18 CFR § 35 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, an original and five copies each of this letter and the following:



These sheets have been revised to change the address of PacifiCorp for any Open Access Transmission Tariff notification requirements. As part of PacifiCorp's efforts to prepare for the implementation of Section 404 of the Sarbanes Oxley Act of 2002, the company has examined its cash receipt controls, policies and procedures in various areas of its operations. PacifiCorp is proposing to improve its receipt and recording controls by requiring all transmission and generation interconnection customers to provide all written notifications to a centralized office, which necessitates the address change proposed herein. This filing does not change any other of the Open Access Transmission Tariff procedures or the allowed methods for non-written notifications.

PacifiCorp requests that a waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to 18 CFR § 35.11 be granted and that an effective date of December 21, 2004 for the enclosed revised tariff sheets be assigned.
