Pursuant to the Commission’s Notice of Filing dated February 9, 2005, and in accordance with Rule 214 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“FERC”) Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, Roseburg Forest Products Co. (“Roseburg”) respectfully submits this motion to intervene in this proceeding. In support of this request Roseburg states as follows:

2. Roseburg is a wood product manufacturing company located in Roseburg, Oregon. In December 2001, Roseburg and PacifiCorp entered into a generator interconnection agreement. On February 4, 2005, PacifiCorp filed the interconnection agreement with Roseburg in this docket. Therefore, Roseburg has a vital and unique interest in this proceeding, and no other party adequately represents Roseburg’s interests.

3. Roseburg believes its participation in this proceeding will assist the Commission in its consideration of the interconnection agreement between PacifiCorp and Roseburg. Furthermore, Roseburg's intervention in this proceeding will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

4. In addition, Roseburg and PacifiCorp intend to file a joint letter in support of the interconnection agreement between PacifiCorp and Roseburg, which also corrects some of PacifiCorp's data in the Company's initial filing regarding Roseburg's facility.

WHEREFORE, Roseburg respectfully requests: (1) that FERC grant leave to Roseburg to intervene in the above-entitled proceeding in accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 385.214; and (2) that FERC make Roseburg a party with full rights to have notice to and rights of participation in any hearings held in connection with this proceeding.
