Dear Mr. Jakubiak:

On December 28, 2005, you submitted for filing, on behalf of PacifiCorp (PacifiCorp), revisions to PacifiCorp's Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) to comply with the requirements of Commission Order Nos. 661 and 661-A. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rules and regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted and the proposed tariff sheets are accepted for filing effective October 14, 2005, as requested.¹

This filing was noticed on January 6, 2006, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before January 18, 2006. No protests or comments were received. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated

therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development -West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
