The matters before the court are defendants' Motion for Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict, Motion for a New Trial, and Renewed Motion for Decertification arising from the Phase II, Damages Trial No. 2. The parties did not request a hearing. The court considered the pleadings, briefs, declarations, exhibits, and arguments submitted to the court.

For the reasons stated in plaintiffs' opposition, defendants' Motion for Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict, Motion for a New Trial, and Renewed Motion for Decertification are DENIED. The court incorporates its prior rulings and orders related to the issues raised in the motions including, without limitation, rulings and orders related to certification and bifurcation, amendment to add punitive damages, summary judgment, motions in limine, pre-
