

The matters before the court are Plaintiffs' Statement for Costs and Disbursements and Defendants' Opposition to Plaintiffs' Statement of Costs and Disbursements arising from the Phase II, Damages Trial 1. The parties did not request a hearing. The court considered the pleadings, briefs, statement for costs and disbursements, declarations, exhibits, memorandum, and arguments submitted to the court. For the reasons stated in plaintiffs' opposition and based on the arguments presented, defendants' objection to Plaintiffs' Statement of Costs and Disbursements is GRANTED as to the \$13,048.50 in daily transcription costs for trial. *See Klutschkowski v. PeaceHealth*, 245 Or App 524, 552 (2011), *aff'd in part, rev'd in part*, 354 Or

150 (2013) (holding that “the trial court erred in awarding plaintiffs the cost of preparing daily trial transcripts.”).

There were no objections to the other costs and disbursements sought by plaintiffs. Accordingly, pursuant to ORCP 68 A(2) and ORCP 32 F (2), the court further orders that plaintiffs are awarded reasonable and necessary costs and disbursements for (i) court costs and filing fees in the amount of \$1,750, and (ii) service of subpoenas and witness fees in the amount of \$74.00.

Plaintiffs shall submit a supplemental judgment and money award consistent with the court’s rulings, after conferral regarding the form of judgment, and within 30 days of the date this order is signed.
