

PacifiCorp will host a virtual public meeting to share information on its Initial Study Report (ISR) for the relicensing of the Cutler Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. 2420) on **Tuesday, February 23, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** (Mountain Time). The purpose of this meeting, required by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, is to share results of the first year of studies and gather input from stakeholders on the study results. The meeting will be held online via the Microsoft Teams app and may be accessed using a link or audio (you do not need a separate account in Teams to join the meeting).

PacifiCorp's ISR for relicensing of the Cutler Hydroelectric Project will be filed with the FERC no later than February 9, 2021. The ISR contains PacifiCorp's study methods and results for studying the effects of proposed operations of the Cutler Project to potentially affected resources including threatened and endangered species, shoreline, land use, fish and aquatic, water quality, sediment, cultural, and recreation resources, as well as providing details of a hydraulic modeling effort. At the February 23, 2021 meeting, stakeholders will be given the opportunity to collaborate with and provide comments to the technical experts who completed these studies. The ISR will be available on the FERC's eLibrary once filed; a link to the ISR will also be on PacifiCorp's Cutler website.
