2. Unequivocal Statement of Intent:

PacifiCorp intends to file an application for a new license for the Cutler Hydroelectric Project (Project) located on the Bear River near the city of Logan in Box Elder and Cache counties in Utah utilizing Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) Integrated Licensing Process (ILP).

3. Description of Principal Project Works to be Licensed:

Proposed project features to be licensed include a reservoir with a surface area of 5,459 acres and storage of 13,200 acre-feet, a concrete arch gravity dam that is 545-feet-long by 109-feet-high, an intake tower and two irrigation canal intakes, an 18-foot-diameter steel penstock, an 81-foot-high surge tank, two 112-foot-long steel penstocks that bifurcate at the surge tank, a brick 60-feet by 123-feet powerhouse, two turbines, two generators, two circuit breakers, two step-up transformers, and appurtenant facilities. A complete outline of all project facility dimensions is available in Section 5.2 of the Pre-Application Document.

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8. Designation as Non-Federal Representative and Authorization to Initiate Consultation

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 5.5(e), PacifiCorp requests that FERC designate it as the non-federal representative for purposes of consultation under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act and the joint agency regulations thereunder at 50 C.F.R. Part 402, section 305(b) of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery and Conservation and Management Act and the implementing regulations at 50 C.F.R. 600.920. In addition, PacifiCorp requests authorization to initiate consultation under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and to implement regulations at 36 C.F.R. Section 800.2(c)(4).

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
