Filing of Scoping Document 1**


Dear Secretary Bose:

On August 13, 2015, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) authorized and approved PacifiCorp's request to follow the Alternative Licensing Process (ALP) for the Weber Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 1744-039). Pursuant to that approval and in accordance with the required notice for the planned scoping meetings, enclosed is Scoping Document 1, along with a two-page cover letter to interested parties. Hard copies of these documents are being distributed to the parties on the Official FERC Weber Mailing List, and electronic copies are being distributed to the parties on the PacifiCorp Supplemental Weber Mailing List.

In collaboration with FERC staff, two scoping meetings have been scheduled for October 6, 2015, along with a project facility visit and initial study plan meeting on October 7, 2015. Publication of a Public Notice for Scoping Document 1 and the date and location of these meetings in the Ogden Standard Examiner, a local daily newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the project is located, will occur no later than September 4, 2015. Proof of this publication will be subsequently e-filed with FERC.
