**Subject: Weber Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 1744)  
Filing of Requested Proof of Newspaper Re-Notice**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On May 29, 2015, pursuant to the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for the Alternative Licensing Process (ALP), 18 CFR §§ 4.34, 5.5, and 5.6, PacifiCorp submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) to File an Application for New License, and a Pre-Application Document (PAD) for PacifiCorp's Weber Hydroelectric Project, FERC Project No. 1744 (Project), located on the Weber River in northeastern Utah. PacifiCorp requested to use the FERC ALP to provide the framework for its consultation with agencies, tribes, and other stakeholders for the Weber Project relicensing. This request has the support of key stakeholders. In accordance with 18 CFR §§ 5.3, PacifiCorp also provided a copy of the Weber Project Communication Protocol, drafted and reviewed with the assistance of interested parties to the Weber relicensing process, and published notice of the filing of the PAD and related NOI, and of the request to use the ALP. This notice was filed concurrently with the PAD and NOI in the Ogden Standard Examiner, a daily newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the project is located.

Per the request of FERC, PacifiCorp hereby submits proof of newspaper re-notice, filed on July 10, 2015, in the Ogden Standard Examiner, a daily newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the project is located. This notice includes the requirement that parties commenting on choice of the ALP process have 30 days from the date of this notice (until August 10, 2015), and must submit their comments to FERC in accordance with filing procedures posted on the FERC web site at <http://www.ferc.gov> and must reference FERC No. 1744.
