**Subject: Weber Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. P-1744)**  
**Filing of Final Study Plans for Alternative Licensing Process**

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) regulations for the Alternative Licensing Process (ALP; 18 CFR §4.34), PacifiCorp hereby submits a set of final study plans for PacifiCorp's Weber Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. P-1744 (Project), located on the Weber River in northeastern Utah.

Pursuant to 18 CFR §4.34, PacifiCorp conducted study plan meetings with Project stakeholders and the FERC on October 6 and 7, 2015, and subsequently with two working groups established during the initial study plan meetings, the Fisheries Working Group (FWG) and the Recreation Working Group (RWG). The FWG has met three times in early 2016; the RWG met once. Both subgroups discussed various Weber Project revised draft study plans (draft Weber study plans were filed with the FERC on November 18, 2015). Stakeholder comments regarding the revised draft study plans are summarized in the attached document titled *Weber Revised Draft Study Plan Comments*. This document identifies the study plan resource area, commenting entity, section #, comment, and resolution. In accordance with stakeholder discussions at the October 6-7 meetings, interested parties are requested to file any responses or comments to the final study plans with FERC within 30 days of the date of this letter, by May 4, 2016.

PacifiCorp is also providing this cover letter to the entities on the FERC Mailing List. These entities include resource agencies, Indian tribes, non-governmental organizations, and members of the general public that FERC has identified as having potential interest in the proceedings. The final study plans are available for review on PacifiCorp's Project relicensing web page at <http://www.pacifiCorp.com/es/hydro/hl/weber.html>.
