**Subject: Weber Hydroelectric Project (FERC No. P-1744)
Comments on Draft Environmental Assessment for Hydropower License**

Dear Ms. Bose:

On May 30, 2018, pursuant to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) regulations for the Alternative Licensing Process (ALP; 18 CFR § 4.34(i)), PacifiCorp submitted the Final License Application (FLA) for Major Project—Existing Dam for the Weber Hydroelectric Project (Project), located on the Weber River in northern Utah. On October 16, 2018, FERC issued the Notice of Application and Applicant-Prepared EA Accepted for Filing, Soliciting Motions to Intervene and Protests, and Soliciting Comments, and Final Recommendations, Terms and Conditions, and Prescriptions within 60 days of Notice issuance, with reply comments due within 105 days of Notice issuance.

PacifiCorp has reviewed the public comments and/or requests which were received prior to the December 15, 2018 deadline. Of the four parties responding, the U.S. Forest Service provided their Weber 4(e) Terms and Conditions, along with a request for intervenor status; American Whitewater supplied several comments, along with a request for intervenor status; and both the Utah Department of Natural Resources and Trout Unlimited simply requested intervenor status.

PacifiCorp has no comments at this time regarding these stakeholder submissions on the Weber Hydroelectric Project's FLA. Further, PacifiCorp has reviewed the procedural schedule published with FERC's October 2018 solicitation and awaits any questions you may have while developing FERC's Environmental Assessment of the Weber FLA, currently scheduled to be completed by July 2019.
