To whom this may concern,

My name is Trevor Steiner and I live in Kemmerer Wyoming. I live near the Naughton Power Plant, which has been forecasted to close down in the next couple of years. I work as a Physician Assistant. I am new to Kemmerer, but have become concerned with the possible closure of the Power Plant in the next couple of years.

Even though my job isn't directly affected by the closure of the power plant, there will most definitely be an indirect effect on my job. Kemmerer and the adjacent town of Diamondville have a population of 3,393 together based on the 2010 census. After some research, I've found that the Plant employs near 126 employees. That may not be a significant number in most towns, but for a town as small as ours, this could be significant. Those 126 employees would include their families, making the total loss to the community greater. This closure would decrease the patient volume in our community. The closure would cause a significant decrease in revenue for the hospital whether it's from patient visits, surgeries, or from the income from the mill levy. I'm also concerned with what affect the closure of the power plant may have on the adjacent Westmoreland Coal Mine, which employs 300 employees. The closure of the Power Plant may be inevitable at this point in the future, but extending the closure for an additional 5-10 more years would allow the community to better prepare for the changes.

PacifiCorp appreciates your feedback and recognizes the importance of establishing a resource plan with consideration of reliability, deliverability, implementation, employee and community impacts.

The Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) helps establish a data set by evaluating economic outcomes for retail customers, while considering risk associated with planning uncertainties. This data set is one element of PacifiCorp's resource plan and associated decision making. At this stage, the IRP process has been focused on the data set. Nonetheless, PacifiCorp is focused on ultimately delivering a resource plan that considers the impact on our employees and the communities in which they live. At this time, analysis for the 2019 IRP is ongoing and a final least-cost, least-risk preferred portfolio has not been selected. PacifiCorp has entered the portfolio-development phase in the IRP, but has not yet established a preferred portfolio nor an associated action plan to deliver that portfolio. No final decisions have been made based on analysis performed to date.
