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To the administrators of PacifiCorp:

My name is Scott Erickson and my wife and I have lived in Kemmerer for thirteen years. We have enjoyed the quality of life raising our seven children while I have been employed by two not-for profit agencies: nine years with High County Behavioral Health, our local community based behavioral health center and now for four years with South Lincoln Hospital District. For the past fifteen months I have also provided counseling services to our community in a small private practice.

Our family has a vested interest in your organization continuing its active investment in our community, particularly through continuing your current strategy of coal-fired energy.

Our local hospital absolutely depends on the investment of resources from the tax levy (mill levy) for its basic operations. Many of the patients we serve are employees of PacifiCorp and without their patronage it is doubtful we could survive as an essential component of the community.

If South Lincoln Hospital District is forced to constrict/eliminate services, it is possible if not likely that my employment will be at risk. If this occurs, being one of two counselors actively providing services in the area, the community would lose this important service. Without sounding too extreme, this would likely result in an increase of behavioral health needs with the trickle down effect of an increase in the number of deaths by suicide. I have personally intervened clinically with four individuals over the past year that likely would have died by suicide without my intervention.

Lastly, I am also an ecclesiastical leader of a church congregation of 300+ individuals, many of whom work for PacifiCorp or have a family member who does so. IN my heart, I do believe it would be best for these individuals and families

### **PacifiCorp Response:**

PacifiCorp appreciates your feedback and recognizes the importance of establishing a resource plan with consideration of reliability, deliverability, implementation, employee and community impacts.

The Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) helps establish a data set by evaluating economic outcomes for retail customers, while considering risk associated with planning uncertainties. This data set is one element of PacifiCorp's resource plan and associated decision making. At this stage, the IRP process has been focused on the data set. Nonetheless, PacifiCorp is focused on ultimately delivering a resource plan that considers the impact on our employees and the communities in which they live. At this time, analysis for the 2019 IRP is ongoing and a final least-cost, least-risk preferred portfolio has not been selected. PacifiCorp has entered the portfolio-development phase in the IRP, but has not yet established a preferred portfolio nor an associated action plan to deliver that portfolio. No final decisions have been made based on analysis performed to date.
