PacifiCorp Response (7/11/22)

The Company expects that IIJA funds will help to build out a fast-charging network to support the deployment of electric vehicles across our six-state service territory. The connection of these actions/investments to the IRP would be reflected/captured through the load forecast used to inform the IRP planning process.

At this time, the processes by which these funds will be distributed is in the early stages of development and not fully known. For example, the Department of Energy (DOE) has not developed specific programs and funding opportunities (or the rules and conditions) yet. However, PacifiCorp has had productive discussions with DOE and are planning a subsequent discussion in July 2022. PacifiCorp is in the early phases of actively collaborating with our state jurisdictions, as a majority of IIJA funds for grid projects will be allocated to each state. We are closely monitoring the release of any new information on the IIJA programs to make sure we fully understand expectations and program details before finalizing our plans to seek IIJA funds.
