Developing Diverse Marketing Materials: We developed recruitment videos featuring diverse participants.




Diversifying Recruitment Channels: Intentionally collaborating with CBO and using a variety of platforms to promote the opportunity.




YTD POST-MEETING SURVEY RESULTS
