

HYDRO SOUTH DAY USE AREA REGULATIONS

Hours

Sunrise to Sunset

Vehicle/parking

- The speed limit in all recreation areas is 5 miles per hour.
- Use only designated roadways and parking areas.
- Off-road use of motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles and ATVs is not allowed in recreation areas.

Rules

- **Use or possession of alcohol or cannabis is not permitted in any PacifiCorp Energy campground or day use area.**
- **The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (i.e. drones) is not permitted in or near PacifiCorp Energy facilities, infrastructure, or recreation sites.**
- All applicable laws regarding public safety, illegal substances, sanitation, boating and fires will be enforced.
- All fires shall be confined to company fireplaces or manufactured grills.
- Campfires are not allowed during Extreme fire season. Fire restrictions are posted on the Information board.
- Fireworks and other flammable materials are not permitted.
- The discharge of firearms or other devices discharging projectiles within or near any recreation area is not permitted.
- No trees, dead or alive, shall be cut for firewood or any other purpose.
- Damage to trees, vegetation or facilities is not permitted. Wildlife is not to be disturbed.
- Operation of public address systems or other noise producing devices is not permitted.
- Similarly, loud music or any other noise that affects others is not permitted.

- Campsite quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Pets are to be under owner's control at all times and physically restrained by leashes no more than six feet in length. Pet owners are required to clean up and appropriately dispose of animal waste.
- Commercial use of the property, including offers of commercial services on or pertaining to recreation sites, is not permitted without prior written permission. Commercial use includes vending merchandise, site rentals, equipment sales or rentals, advertising, providing services, etc.
- Place bottles, cans, paper, garbage and other rubbish or refuse in receptacles for that purpose.
- Violators of policies are subject to removal and prosecution.
- Any person, who removes, injures, destroys, defaces, excavates, or appropriates any PacifiCorp property structures including historic or prehistoric structures, ruins, artifacts, or object of antiquity on PacifiCorp land is subject to arrest and penalty of law.
- Park users who violate rules will be asked to leave, and thereafter, will be subject to trespass and prosecution if they enter company property.
- Policies are subject to change without notice. We do not accept responsibility for the safety or well-being of recreation area guests.

Special Notes

- **The lake water level is subject to change at any time, use caution when securing your water craft to shore.**
- Swimming activities should be monitored. PacifiCorp does not maintain a lifeguard at any of its recreation facilities.
- River users should be aware of their own ability, river conditions and difficulty level of the river reach before embarking on a river trip.
