**Q01.** In response to Data Request 322 PacifiCorp provided a list of projects that had been delayed due to permitting issues. Regarding these statements, provide the following, applicable to calendar year 2024:

- a) An explanation of all standard (i.e., location) and non-standard (i.e., customer request) types of information PacifiCorp tracks per asset maintenance work order.
- b) An explanation of how PacifiCorp tracks any information with respect to permits needed or obtained for open work orders to proceed to completion with asset maintenance.
- c) An explanation of whether PacifiCorp tracks any information with respect to permits needed or obtained for new construction or replacement projects.
- d) Examples of sample documentation as evidence for PacifiCorp's tracking permitting needs with respect to work orders and new construction.
